AbbyPD Collectible Coin Design Competition

Terms & Conditions

- 1. Entrants must reside, study or work in the City of Abbotsford, Province of British Columbia. There is no age requirement to submit a coin design; however, minors (18 years of age or younger) must have a parent or guardian sign the Release, Assignment and Waiver.
- 2. There is no limit in the number of coin designs that each entrant can submit.
- Entrants may email <u>abbypd25coin@abbypd.ca</u> and request the Release, Assignment and Waiver document as well as the 'Draw & Colour Your Own Coin' document. These documents will be provided in a return email as an attachment.
- 4. The 'Draw & Colour Your Own Coin' document and the Release, Assignment and Waiver document may also be picked up in person at the front counter of the Abbotsford Police Department located at 2838 Justice Way, Abbotsford, BC or the Community Police Office located at #105-34194 Marshall Rd, Abbotsford, BC.
- 5. The Release, Assignment and Waiver document must be completed in full and submitted along with all coin design(s) in order to be officially entered in the AbbyPD Collectible Coin Design Competition.
- 6. Design submissions should be black and white preferably; however, colour submissions are also accepted. The struck coin will be one colour (bronze, silver or gold) with some moderate-relief used to make some design details raised or three-dimensional.
- 7. Coin designs may be submitted via email to abbypd.ca and must be submitted in .psd, .ai, .jpeg, or hand-drawn format. Every .psd, .ai, and .jpeg design submitted must include a .pdf version attached.
- 8. Hand-drawn submissions may be brought to the front counter at the Abbotsford Police Department located at 2838 Justice Way, Abbotsford, BC or the Community Police Office located at #105-34194 Marshall Rd, Abbotsford, BC. Hand-drawn submissions may also be scanned and submitted as an attachment via email to abbypd25coin@abbypd.ca.

9. There is a total of six (6) designs that will be selected as winning entries for this competition that shall consist of the following themes:

a) Courage (bronze colour)
b) Integrity (bronze colour)
c) Service (bronze colour)
d) Honour (bronze colour)
e) Strength in Community (silver colour)
f) Leadership / Chief's Coin (gold colour)

- 10. The final dimensions of the Courage, Integrity, Service, and Honour theme coins will be 30 mm by 2.5 mm. The final dimensions of the Strength in Community and Leadership / Chief's Coin will be 35 mm by 3 mm.
- 11. The competition opens on October 5th, 2019 at 8:00am. Entries close at midnight on November 3, 2019 at 12:00am.
- 12. By entering the AbbyPD Collectible Coin Design Competition, all entrants will be deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these rules.
- 13. By entering the AbbyPD Collectible Coin Design Competition, you give permission to the Abbotsford Police Department to share your entry on the Abbotsford Police Department's Facebook page and any other social media channels.
- 14. Entries will be judged and the winner will be notified, via the email address that was provided by the entrant, no later than December 31, 2019.
- 15. Winners shall have their coin designs used by the Abbotsford Police Department to celebrate the 25th Anniversary throughout the year 2020; however, additional use of the winning coin designs may also be considered.
- 16. Winners shall receive an AbbyPD Collectible Coin collection along with a letter from Chief Constable Mike Serr acknowledging the winning coin designs on behalf of the Abbotsford Police Department.
- 17. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any entrant submitting an entry which, in the opinion of the judges, includes objectionable content, including but not limited to profanity, nudity, potentially insulting, scandalous, inflammatory or defamatory images or language. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 18. The Abbotsford Police Department reserves the right to withdraw or amend the competition as necessary due to circumstances outside its control.
