# 4. Chief's Report

Chief Rich reported on the West Abbotsford Working Group that has been established to find solutions to gang problem and work with at risk youth.

Chief Rich commented on the 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Crime is Toast event taking place the next morning, noting that it is a sold out event. He noted that the focus of his speech will be to get the community thinking in terms of 'We' and to encourage the community to solve problems, such as homelessness, fentanyl, gangs, etc., together using a 'hub' model.

Deputy Serr reported that a young 13 year old boy, who had already suffered traumatically in his life when his grandparents perished in a fire, was recently robbed, at knife point, of his bicycle. Later today the APD and Sport Check we will present him with a new bicycle.
