## Live Chat with the AbbyPD

Can't find how to obtain a Police Check? Looking for information about policing as a career? Let us direct you to the right spot!

To help you find the information you need from the Abbotsford Police Department, a live chat system has been added to the [abbypd.ca](http://abbypd.ca) website. "LiveChat" allows you to communicate quickly and easily with the Abbotsford Police via instant messaging. Click the chat bubble in the lower right of any [abbypd.ca](http://abbypd.ca) page - a chat window pops up and you're prompted to provide your contact info and start your conversation.

If you have initiated your chat during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 9:00 am – 5:00 am), you will be quickly connected with an operator. If an operator is not available or you are messaging outside of regular business hours, you may leave a message and we'll get back to you as soon as possible.

**Please note that LiveChat should not be used to report crime or in-progress incidents.** There are many alternatives to report non-emergency incidents to AbbyPD including:
