Abbotsford – June 16, 2009.

On Monday June 22 at 9:00 am the Abbotsford Police Department will participate in their leg of the Law Enforcement Torch Run in support of Special Olympics. Abbotsford Police staff, other Law Enforcement personnel and Special Olympians will be departing from the front doors of the Abbotsford Police Department (2838 Justice Way) and finishing at the Eagle's Club (33868 Essendene Avenue). The objective of this run will be to raise funds for this very worthy cause. This year the Special Olympics British Columbia Summer Games are being held in Abbotsford from July 9 to 12. 1500 athletes, coaches and other staff will be coming to our city for this amazing event. The Law Enforcement Torch Run participants will be stopping at various points on the route and hope to encounter many supporters along the way. The run should take just over an hour.

The Law Enforcement Torch Run will continue in other communities through June 25 with the objective of reaching a total distance of 100 km.
