### Incident: Abbotsford Police Investigate 2 Hit and Run Incidents

**Abbotsford – December 15, 2010.**

On Monday December 13 at 7:20 pm a driver noticed a 20 year old woman injured on the side of the road in the area of Montrose Avenue and Laurel Street. The female had a significant laceration to her head and remembered seeing vehicle lights before the impact. She was not able to describe the vehicle or driver that left her injured at the scene. The woman was released from hospital later that evening.

This morning at 2:30 am another driver observed an injured 25 year old male cyclist in the curb of Garden Street near Simon Avenue. Although the cyclist was wearing a helmet he still suffered several substantial injuries to various areas of his body including his head. Police have received information that he was struck by a black vehicle, possibly a Ford Mustang, which fled the area immediately after the collision. The cyclist was transported to hospital by helicopter where he remains in serious condition.
