Incident: Indecent Acts

Abbotsford – May 11, 2011.

On Sunday, April 24 at 5:30 pm two young girls, 9 and 11 years of age were playing near Rotary Stadium Park in the 32400 block of Haida Drive. The girls were approached by an Indo-Canadian man who exposed himself and then fled the area on foot. The Abbotsford Police believe this is the same man who exposed himself to two 9 year olds girls in the same location on Saturday, March 5 at 4:00 pm. Major Crime detectives have identified a person of interest in regard to these incidents and are continuing to investigate.

This man is described as late 20's, 5'8" to 5'10" and weighing 180 to 200 pounds.

On Thursday, May 5 at 5:45 pm a 75 year old woman was walking in the 2400 block of Countess Street when a Caucasian man in a black car asked her for the time. As the woman prepared to respond to the man she noticed that he was fondling himself and was grinning at her. The woman informed the man that she was calling police and he immediately left the area.

That man was described at having pale skin, 30-40 years of age, weighing approximately 200 pounds with short brown receding hair. The suspect was driving a newer black sedan.

Police are asking the public to be aware of these incidents and are recommending adult supervision for children in the area of Rotary Stadium Park. Anyone with information about these incidents is asked to contact the Abbotsford Police at 604-859-5225 or Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-8477.
