Incident: Home Invasion Robbery, One Man Arrested

Abbotsford – July 5, 2011.

Last night at 9:35 pm the Abbotsford Police received a call of a home invasion at a residence in the 4100 block of Bradner Road. A couple was in the home when 2 males barged in, deployed "pepper spray" and demanded cash. The suspects left with a small quantity of electronics and fled on foot. A short time later police received a phone call from residents in the 28000 block of Fraser Highway reporting a man on their property attempting to change his clothes. When confronted by these residents the man indicated that he was "pepper sprayed" by his girlfriend during an argument. Abbotsford Police Patrol Division officers located this individual, a 22 year old Abbotsford man with an extensive history with police. In his possession was an electronic item matching one taken from the victim's home. The man was arrested and should appear in court later today.

The second male involved in the incident was not located. He was described as a Caucasian male, 5'10" to 6'0" feet tall, stocky build wearing a dark coloured hoody and blue jeans.
