Incident: Last Stolen of 2011 = Prolific Offender arrested in 2012

Abbotsford: January 9, 2012

On December 30, 2011 the Abbotsford Police Department received what would be the last stolen vehicle report of the year. A 2010 Chevrolet Equinox was stolen from the 32000 block of Chilcotin Drive. The Crime Reduction Unit (CRU) of the Abbotsford Police Department focused on several prolific offenders as possible suspects for the theft. The investigation included surveillance of a 25 year old "super prolific offender" from Abbotsford. On Thursday, January 5, 2012 the work of CRU, with the assistance of the Integrated Municipal Provincial Auto Crime Team, paid off with the arrest of Clayton Burton ORR, in addition to a 22 year old man and a 17 year old girl in the stolen vehicle. The vehicle and its occupants had travelled through other Fraser Valley communities prior to the arrest. ORR has been remanded into custody and is facing Possession of Stolen Property and Prohibited Driving charges. Credit cards and other items found in the vehicle are part of the continuing investigation by CRU.

Clayton ORR is deemed to be a "super prolific offender" by the fact he has been convicted over 30 times. APD CRU targets prolific property offenders and works with other policing jurisdictions to arrest offenders who commit crimes in Abbotsford. In 2011 the hard work of the Abbotsford Police Crime Reduction Unit contributed to the overall reduction of property crime by 6.5% and decreased stolen autos by 21%.
