Incident: Update 2 - Man with Serious Injuries located in Mill Lake Park

Abbotsford - April 2, 2012.

The Abbotsford Police have arrested the 3 people responsible for the assault that sent a 30 year old man to hospital with serious injuries in the early morning hours of March 28, 2012. All three are female youths from Abbotsford. Two of the girls are 15 and one is 16 years of age. Each will be facing charges of Aggravated Assault as a result of the dispute that erupted between the girls and the victim in Mill Lake Park.

Release of March 29, 2012 Below:

The medical condition of the 30 year old assault victim continues to improve. Our investigation is advancing but we continue to seek information from witnesses and others. APD Major Crime detectives have a particular interest in speaking with 3 people who were in the area and were approached by the citizen who discovered the injured man:

The first is a man who was approached in the area of South Fraser Way before 4 am and told there was a body in Mill Lake Park. The man responded "Well, you better call the police then."

The second and third were together in a vehicle that was flagged down shortly thereafter. The man and woman in the vehicle drove into the park area. The woman called 911 from a payphone.

Investigators would like to speak to all three of these individuals.

Initial Release Below:

Our Mission:

In Mill Lake Park at 4:00 am this morning a citizen located a 30 year old man suffering from numerous injuries. Police, fire and ambulance were called and responded immediately. The injured man was assessed and assisted at scene before being transported to hospital. The Abbotsford Police Patrol Division, Major Crime Unit and Forensic Identification Unit are investigating the incident.

Although the investigation is in the early stages, we believe that the man was with a group of individuals when the incident took place. For that reason we are appealing for them to contact the APD. Our investigators will be working to identify those who witnessed or were involved in the assault that has left this man in serious condition.

There will be areas of the park with limited access as the investigation continues in daylight through the morning hours.

Updates will be provided as more information becomes available.
