Incident: Abbotsford Police release Operation X Documentary

Abbotsford – July 17, 2012.

The documentary film Operation X, which was shown to thousands of Abbotsford secondary and middle school students before the conclusion of the school year, is now available and accessible to the public. The gripping and emotional stories of Tyler Miller and Cheryl McCormack, two Abbotsford youths who became tragic victims of the street drug ecstasy in late 2011, are the focus of the film. It took tremendous courage on the part of the families and friends of Cheryl and Tyler to tell their stories in order to prevent others from becoming victims or from having their own tragic tales to tell. On March 16, 2012 a 24 year old Abbotsford man's life was saved by his awareness of what happened to Tyler and Cheryl. We hope this film will serve to educate more people and save many more lives.
