Incident: Update to Shooting Incident on Walsh Avenue

Evidence gathered last night indicates that a vehicle and its occupants were targeted at the shooting incident on Walsh Avenue. The same vehicle arrived at the hospital and two of the occupants had gun shots wounds. One of the males was treated for his injuries and released from the hospital last night, the second male remains in hospital in stable condition with serious injuries. This was a targeted shooting at those involved in the Towline Hill Conflict.

Initial News Release:

This evening, at 7:54 pm, the Abbotsford Police received a call alerting them to possible shots fired in the 33200 block of Walsh Ave. Upon arrival, APD Patrol Officers were unable to locate a victim, however, an area search was conducted and evidence located to confirm a shooting had occurred.

Shortly after the shooting, two males arrived at the hospital with gunshot wounds. The two males remain in hospital where they are receiving treatment for their injuries. The Major Crime Unit of the Abbotsford Police Department has assumed this investigation and continues to investigate.
